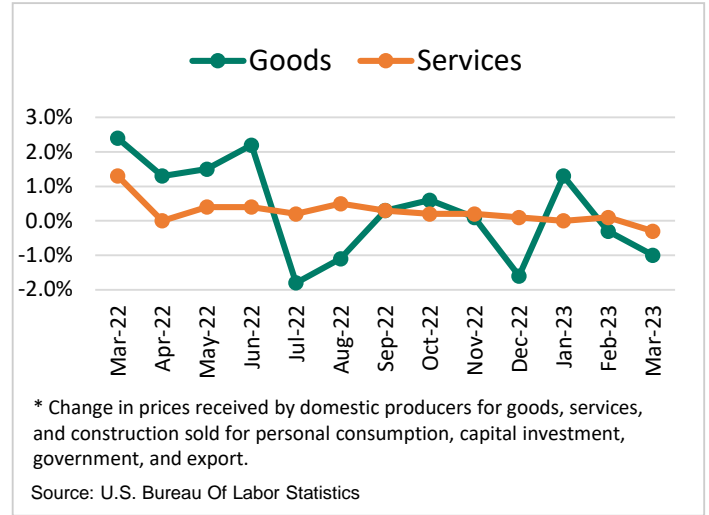

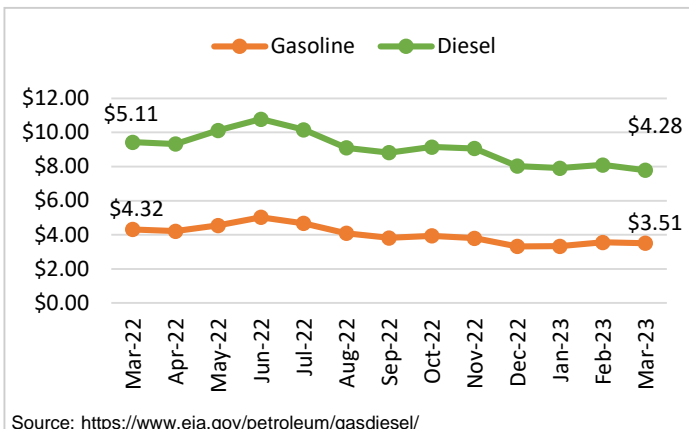

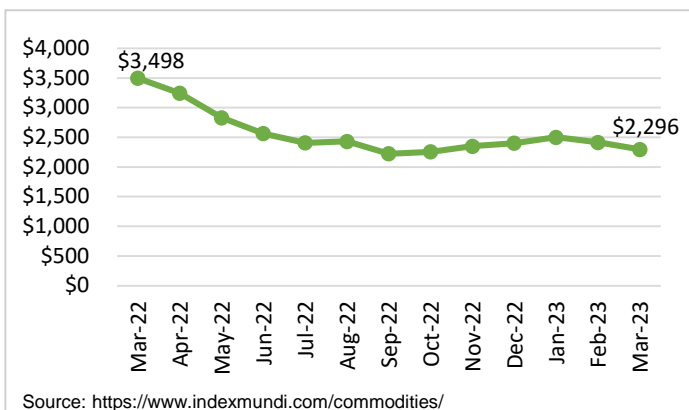

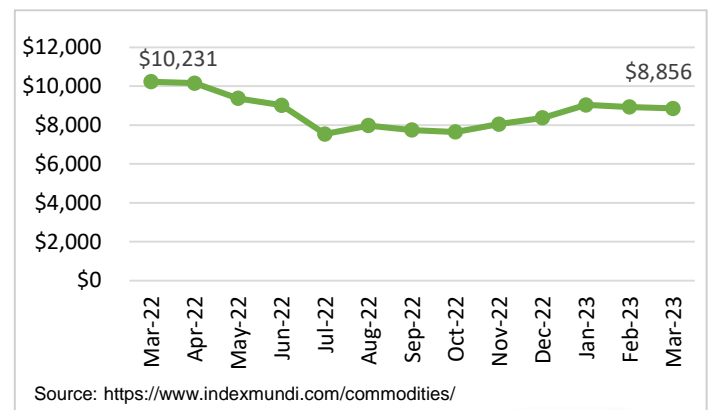

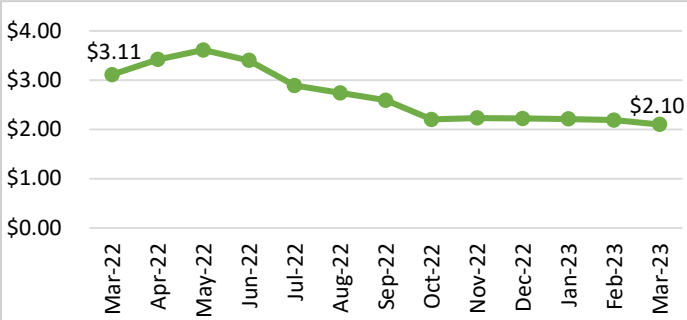
## Aluminum – Per Ton



## Copper – Per Ton

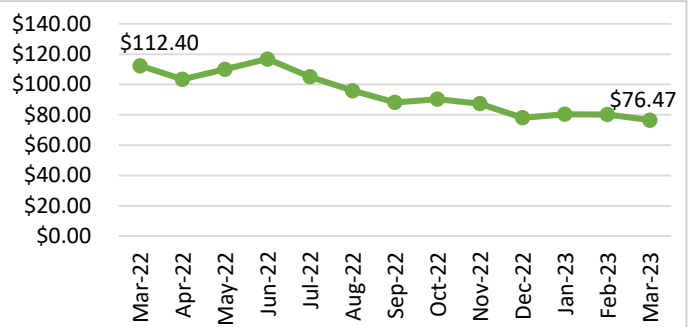


## Cotton – Per Kilogram



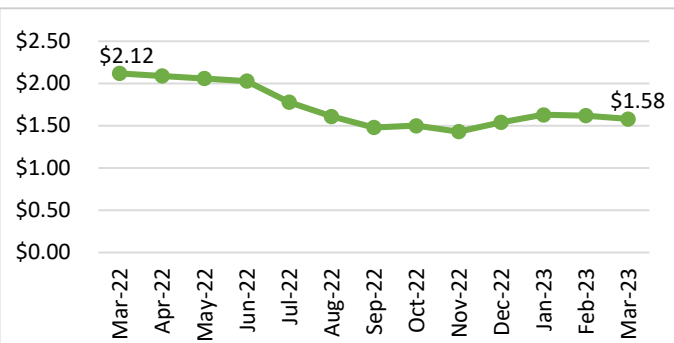

## Crude Oil Petroleum – Per Barrel



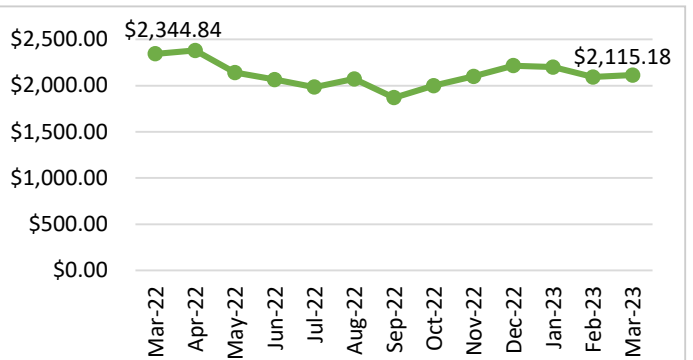
