## **Occupancy On The Rise But Access Remains Limited**

- → SNF demand is expected to increase as more than 20% of the U.S.population will be over the age of 65 by 2030
- → Nearly 50% of nursing homes are limiting new admissions
- → 23% of SNFs turn away residents more than once a week due to:
  - Labor shortages
  - Rising costs
  - Government underfunding

**42%** of senior housing executives predict SNF occupancy rates will improve by 2026
